## BUS AGREEMENT

Dear AFP Families,

Ahwatukee Foothills Prep is pleased to be able to offer the opportunity for many students to ride a school bus to and from school at no charge to the family provided by First Student. This opportunity is a privilege.

The priority of AFP and First Student is that each child arrives to school and home safely. Therefore, it is expected that all students who ride the school bus follow a code of conduct consistent with school rules and designed to provide the safety that is required for travel on a school bus.

Bus Drivers have the right to assign seats. Students who do not comply with directions from the bus driver may be removed from the bus and lose riding privileges. The bus driver has the right to refuse to transport a student who creates an unsafe environment.

Students are expected to:

- Stay in their seat while on the bus. No moving from seat to seat and no standing up on the bus.
- Keep hands and feet to themselves.
- Refrain from yelling or making loud noises.
- Use school appropriate language
- Refrain from eating or drinking on the bus.
- Refrain from throwing objects.

Students who choose behaviors that violate this agreement risk losing the privilege of riding the bus. Consequences may be imposed range from one day suspension from the bus to permanent suspension from the bus.
