FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: IS THERE BEFORE AND AFTER CARE AVAILABLE? – AFP staff will be at the Boys & Girls Club as early as 7:00 A.M. (no charge) Students who are not picked up by **3:45 P.M.** will be sent to the Boys & Girls Club afterschool program at **PARENT EXPENSE**.

Q: Is BUS SERVICE AVAILABLE? All three bus routes will run their regularly scheduled routes. There is a new stop on the Maricopa route that is right by the old AFP building. Bus Routes and Times are posted on the AFP website at **afprep.org**. Students who are not already bus riders will need to complete a bus permission form prior to riding the bus. The form will be available at the Boys & Girls club on Monday.

Q: ARE SCHOOL UNIFORMS REQUIRED? NO – However, students must wear socks and CLOSED-toed shoes. No flip-flops, please.

Q: WILL LUNCH BE SERVED? No. Students must bring a sack lunch.

Q: IS ATTENDANCE REQUIRED? No. Although we encourage all students to participate, attendance is not required. Students will not be penalized for not attending, nor will there be work or projects that have to be made up.

Q: DOES MY CHILD HAVE TO ATTEND THE ENTIRE TIME? No. Students may attend as few or as many days as he/she wishes. Also, students do not have to attend for an entire day. Parents may choose to drop-off or pick-up any time.

Q: IS THERE A BEHAVIOR PLAN? Student conduct is expected to be respectful. Students who do not choose to follow directions or are disrespectful towards others, will be placed in a time-out area, and a parent will be required to pick up the child. If there is severe inappropriate behavior, the child may not be permitted to return to the Boys & Girls Club.
